BATTING CAGE RULES

Within 1 hour of a team's scheduled game on a field, such team shall have the priority to use the assigned batting cage for pre-game batting practice. Opposing teams are STRONGLY encouraged to agree to share the one hour time in an equitable manner.

Field 3 uses cage 1 on field 5

Field 4 uses cage in left field of Gilbert

Gilbert uses cage in right field of Gilbert

Field 5 uses cage in left field of field 4.

Field 2 uses cage 2 on field 5

In all circumstances, including the game day situation described above, when a team is using a batting cage and any other team is waiting, the team using the cage must limit the use to a total of 30 minutes commencing from the time that the team first entered the batting cage determined on an honor system.

Other than this game day preference, all batting cages on this playground are available for use by all teams in all leagues on a first-come, first-serve basis (except for the 5/6 league, as explained below). No team or league has any preference or priority over any particular batting cage. Teams can only use one batting cage at a time.

The batting cages can only be used by the 4/5/6 leagues when no other league team is using or waiting to use the batting cages. Coaches in the 4/5/6 leagues or any parent utilizing the batting cages for an individual player must vacate the batting cage when coaches and players are ready to use the batting cage assigned to their game field, for pre-game warm up.

If a team is occupying one of our fields for practice, any other team that is not practicing on a field has preference to the batting cage over the team with the field. Due to limited facilities, we cannot allow a field and a batting cage to be tied up by one team. All facilities must be shared.

Anyone pitching to a batter in a batting cage must be at least 18 years of age.

Please make sure your players are told they may not swing the bats while waiting outside a batting cage. All players receiving batting practice must wear protective batting helmets.

We ask all parents and coaches to enforce these safety rules.

Regardless of any rules, we ask that all parents, coaches and players work together and share the batting cages on a reasonable good faith basis.
